## Guidelines to the National Curriculum Levels for Art

### Level 4

You can:

- Use different art materials and techniques
- Collect ideas to develop your artwork
- Explain ideas and techniques for project work using words and drawings
- Make different types of artwork
- Discuss your ideas and understand various art key words.
- Discuss and describe the work and techniques of artists and designers and use it to improve your own work.
- Change work whilst you are making it to meet the need you have identified.

### Level 5

You can:

- Use a range of art materials and suitable techniques.
- Collect ideas and make judgements to develop your art work.
- Communicate ideas and techniques for project work.
- Choose and make artwork for different uses, checking that it meets the need you have identified.
- Discuss ideas confidently using some art key words.
- Discuss and describe the work and techniques of artists and designers and recognise how work is produced in different ways to meet different needs.
- Change work whilst you are making it to meet the need you have identified.

### Level 6

You can:

- Use and select from a range of art materials and techniques.
- Collect ideas and make judgements to develop your art work and ideas.
- Communicate ideas and techniques for project work.
- Choose and make artwork for different uses, checking that it communicates with the people.
- Discuss ideas confidently using a range of art key words.
- Discuss judge, and describe the work and techniques of artists and designers and recognise how work is produced in different ways to meet different needs.
- You discuss and change work and judge how successful it is.

### Level 7 and 8

You can:

- Use a range of materials and techniques selecting and using them in the most **creative** way possible.
- Collect ideas and make judgements to develop your artwork and ideas.
- Communicate ideas and techniques for project work with confidence skill and **understanding**.
- Choose and make artwork for different uses, checking that it meets the purpose and **situation** for which it is designed.
- Discuss ideas **fluently** using appropriate language.
- Discuss judge, describe and **relate** to the work and techniques of artists and designers and understand how a **range** of work is produced in different ways to meet different needs.
- Discuss, change and judge work independently **assessing** how successful it is, whilst using a wider range of materials.

The words in **bold** type in each National Curriculum Level describe the things that you must do to improve your Attainment Level.
