#### Assessment

In the Middle School, we have 'Progress Tests' throughout the year, which help us track each students' progress in each subject. These tests also allow our teachers to plan for every students specific learning needs, which helps our students make as much progress as possible from the start to the end of the uear. To support students progress we use CAT4 data analysis to help us understand the learning styles of each and every student in the Middle School. We capture data across the middle school throughout the uear, which helps us review our learning strategies, craft our curriculum and teaching to meet the needs of all students and to improve their outcomes.

End of term reports are generated throughout the year for our students and their parents. This allows us to show you the individual progress that your child is making in each subject and helps us work with you to establish specific plans to enhance uour child's learning. In addition to this we run parents meetings throughout the uear. This gives parents the opportunity to come and meet with every teacher that their child is taught by.

We have a strong leadership structure at GEMS Wellington International School, from the head of school all the way to our student leaders, everyone contributes to the successful leadership of our Middle School.

We are proud holders of the High Performance Learning World Class Schools award. High Performance Learning is a research-based, pedagogy-led philosophy that responds to our growing understanding of human capability. It normalises high performance for all students and uses a unique teaching and learning framework to systematically develop the cognitive skills, values, attitudes and attributes needed for lifetime success.

This year we have had a focus on High Performance Learning. It is very evident when you are in the school that this is truly becoming a part of our learning culture; from the children articulating their learning in the classroom, to children working collaboratively and engaging in creative and critical thinking tasks across all areas of learning.

High Performance Learning is carefully planned within the lessons which incorporate the 5 Advanced Cognitive Performance Characteristics (ACPs) or as our children understand them as 'The 5 learning brains': Meta-cognition Brain, Linking Brain, Realising Brain, Creating Brain and Analysing Brain and the 3 Values Attitudes and Attributes (VAAs); Empathetic, Agile and Hard-working.
