

At GEMS Wellington International School your child will experience a highly effective and inclusive environment which will inspire them to achieve and succeed.

Our school offers a unique structure for students to support their education through the model of a Lower, Middle and Upper School. With this, students will journey from FS1 to Year 4 in our Lower School focusing on learning through play and active learning in our bespoke 'Learning Zones' which help students develop their creativity, motor skills, STEAM understanding and digital awareness, truly engaging and exciting them about learning and the wider world. The transition into the Middle School in Year 5 sees students developing their independence and critical thinking skills



through a tailored curriculum taught by core specialist teachers, including secondary specialists who focus on enhancing the curriculum across Year 5 and Year 6, making a seamless transition into Year 7. Throughout Middle School, we continue to embed High Performance Learning (HPL) through carefully planned lessons which incorporate the 5 Advanced Cognitive Performance Characteristics (ACPs) and are identified as the following skills: Meta-cognition, Linking, Realising, Creating and Analysing.

From here, students' learning skills continue to develop; GCSE skills and attributes are mapped back to fully prepare our students for when they progress into the Upper School. In 2020-21, more than one third of our students gained a minimum of 40 IBDP points, which is particularly impressive as the world average IBDP points is 33. Furthermore, the number of students achieving 35 points or above has more than doubled in the last two years.

At WIS, this journey to success is accelerated in Year 10 and 11, with the breadth of subjects on offer for GCSE, including Business Studies, Design Technology and Psychology and we pride ourselves on preparing our students for Higher Education through personalised support, learning and pathways which encourage independence, debate and discussion. We are proud of what our educational culture instills and we are still one of the highest achieving non-selective schools in Dubai.

As a fully inclusive international school, enabling a first-class educational experience for students aged three to eighteen years, we ensure that all students are supported and challenged to achieve success. We recognise the uniqueness of each child through learning opportunities that promote challenge and personalised learning at all levels. A plethora of enriching learning opportunities, within and beyond the classroom, ensure that students enjoy sporting and benefit from highly creative and stimulating experiences. Visits, trips, team competitions, our Explore, Enrich Excite (EEE) programme, which offers a range of clubs and extra activities, as well as an emphasis on memorable learning moments ensure high levels of engagement at WIS, which supports outstanding attainment and progress from Foundation Stage through to IB level.
